Gordon is the Founder and Chief Editor of "News Source Guyana", which is an independent media company in Guyana.

Gordon Moseley grounded his feet in journalism while in the final year of High School in Linden, where he would work weekends at the Linden Weekend News.

Upon completion of High School, he moved to Georgetown where he joined the team at Captiol News, beginning as a Reporter and quickly rising through the ranks as a news anchor, senior reporter and news editor.

Gordon left Capitol News after 14 years in 2013, and three months later, he founded News Source Guyana.

News Source Guyana quickly broke ground as one of the leading online news agencies in the country and has continued to be one of the most objective and trusted news organisations in Guyana.

While managing News Source and its daily operations, Gordon also launched his radio career at 94.1Boom FM in Georgetown as the first host of their morning programme, Jumpstart. He remained with Jumpstart for over 11 years, but left last December to focus more on his news operations and new programming under the News Source banner.

Over the years, Gordon has completed training from the United Nations, the US State Department through Colombia and Oklahoma Universities, the Canadian High Commission and training organisations in Asia and across the Caribbean.

He is a former two-time President of the Guyana Press Association and currently sits on its executive.

Over the years, he has served as a correspondent for CNN International and the Caribbean Media Corporation.

He has also repeatedly used his social media pages of more than 300,000 followers to highlight and promote many angles of the Guyanese culture.
